Conductive Gel Pad Placement:

The inside of the garment has been printed with conductive gel pad placement guides, showing you exactly where to place the 4 conductive gel pads. The locations will vary depending on your size (A/a and B/b).



 Lay out the conductive garment on a flat surface with the white markings facing you.



3. Place the gel pads, grid pattern side down, firmly on the garment within area determined during initial fitting.



Remove the clear plastic liners from the patterned side of the 4 conductive gel pads.



4. Remove the plastic liners from the gel pads. Do not throw these away as you will need them later for storing the Kneehab XP.

Conductive Gel Pad Care:

Your conductive gel pads will last longer with proper care:

- + After use, leave gel pads on the Kneehab and place the plastic liners back on the pads.
- + Place garment in storage bag.
- + To improve adhesive strength, re-hydrate gel pad with a few drops of water and massage gently into gel. With proper care, as per manual, gel pads have an estimated usage of 20 sessions.
